General Tips

Adhere to instructions and advice given by the manufacturer (stability zone for the batteries temperature, number of charges, no full discharge)	
Always use the original charger and make sure the wires are in good condition and well out of the way.	
Continuously monitor your battery throughout the charging process	
The room in which you are charging your battery should be suitable : ventilated, away from all sources of heat, humidity or flammable/combustible objects	
Always unplug the battery when you've finished charging your device (Try using a charger with an indicator or a recommended charging time)	
In the event of a fire take your battery with you when you evacuate the premises or tell the person in charge of evacuation where your battery is located.	
In the event of abnormal changes in temperature, odor or shape, immediately take your battery outside of the premises and notify your site welcome desk : 04 73 28 89 00
